26 STUDENTS WITH INTELLECTUAL DISABILITIES OF GRIID RECEIVE XTH CLASS CERTIFICATES

Government Rehabilitation Institute for Intellectual Disabilities (GRIID), sector 31 C, Chandigarh, organised the certificate distribution program for its first batch of NIOS secondary course of GRIID students in its premises. The students and parents were very elated to receive their certificates. These students were enrolled in secondary course of NIOS at SAIED centre of GRIID.

Rajni Sood added that when she used to meet staff of GRIID, she used to feel so relaxed as she got all the facilities, training, and guidance for her child under one roof. She was very grateful to GRIID authority. It is one of the best institutions in the area. She requested organising short-term courses for parents from time to time to which Dr Priti Arun replied that keeping in view time constraints of parents and family commitments, workshops for parents will be organised instead of courses.
